The minimum package for students entering the 2021-2022 academic year offers five contiguous years of support that includes a Student Academic Appointment (SAA) in the form of a teaching or research assistantship with a stipend of at least \$24,800 per year (\$21,766 for the 10-month academic year and \$3,034 for the summer). Student Academic Appointees are asked to spend approximately 20 hours each week on their assigned duties or projects. The appointment also includes a fee remission and student health insurance (currently worth \$3,327; see <https://hr.iu.edu/benefits/students.html> for details). The fee remission is currently worth \$39,915 for a non-resident student and covers up to 12 hours of graduate credit each semester and a maximum of six credit hours during the summer term. The fee remission will cover 100% of graduate tuition fees, but does not cover G901, mandatory, course-related, or miscellaneous fees. You should be prepared to pay all mandatory fees, which currently amount to approximately \$705 each semester. International students are required to pay an additional mandatory fee of approx. \$357 per semester. It is our understanding that the fee remission is non-taxable; but the assistantship's stipend is considered taxable income.

Of the graduates in the 2011-2021 window, 61% are licensed. Many of our graduates are in research jobs where licensure is not required, so they do not apply for it. Of the students in the 2011-2021 window who sought licensure, 100% were successful in obtaining it.
