The minimum package for students 2021-2022 is a 5-year financial package that includes a 10-month Student Academic Appointment (SAA) and a departmental summer fellowship. The SSA stipend will be at least \$21,766 and the summer fellowship is \$6,000 per year, for a guaranteed yearly total of at least \$27,766 for five years. Student Academic Appointees generally are asked to spend approximately 20 hours each week on their teaching or assistantship duties during the academic year. You will not have any assistantship duties during the summers, but are required to enroll in at least one credit hour during the summer as a condition of the fellowship. The appointment also includes a fee remission and student health insurance (currently worth \$3,327). The fee remission is currently worth \$39,915 for a non-resident student and covers up to 12 hours of graduate credit each semester and a maximum of six credit hours during the summer term. The fee remission will cover 100% of graduate tuition fees, but does not cover G901, mandatory, course-related, or miscellaneous fees. You should be prepared to pay all mandatory fees, which currently amount to approximately \$705 each semester and \$217-\$545 in the summer (amount depends on credit hours). It is our understanding that the fee remission is non-taxable; but the assistantship stipend is considered taxable income.

Our teaching assistants work up to 20 hours per week during the academic year assisting one or more of our faculty members with their class work. Support for subsequent years is guaranteed provided you maintain a minimum GPA of 3.3 and satisfactory progress towards the degree.
